## **Directions**

Aullwood Farm is located near the intersection of U.S. 40 and Frederick Pike.

From I-70 take exit 32 toward U.S. 40/Dayton Airport. Merge onto Terminal Road which becomes Dayton International Access Road.

Take U.S. 40 exit toward Enlewood/Vandalia and turn left on U.S. 40. Turn left at the traffic light onto Frederick Pike. The farm entrance will be on your right.
