

THE #OHIOSTRONGPCATRAINING PROGRAM

This training program is specifically for applicants that are not already qualified to work in home care, in order to address the Personal Care Aide workforce shortage.

PERSONAL CARE AIDE WORKFORCE SHORTAGE: A number of the older adults across Ohio needing help in order to live safely and comfortably in their own homes (and avoid the necessity of moving to a senior nursing facility) are currently unable to get the home health services they need because of a shortage of personal care aides. Unfortunately, older adults in our nine-county area in West Central Ohio are not immune to this shortage, and we have seen the effects of this shortage in personal care aides increase over the last few years. Dr. Kathy Stevens, a Del Mar Encore Fellow with The Dayton Foundation, initiated the #OHIOSTRONGPCATRAINING program through the Agency on Aging, PSA2 in 2020 to help address this shortfall by offering free CNA Training. The Area Agency on Aging, PSA2 now continues her work. **HELP CONTINUES TO BE NEEDED!!!** If you are interested in working in home health care, are compassionate and want to make a big difference in someone's life, please know there are many home care provider agencies currently hiring personal care aides

Program Costs: There is no cost to apply to this program.

Out of pocket expenses for individuals: background check, scrubs, physical, and TB test. STNA testing is **not** required to work in home health care and is not paid for by this program.

Training Sites:

The program is currently partnered with two training sites. The individual can choose the training option that will work best for their life, but must meet the registration requirements. The training company will bill the Area Agency on Aging for the training cost. **NOTE:** All are state-approved CNA training courses and include the minimum of 75 hours of instruction, 59 hours of classroom instruction and 16 hours of hands-on training ("clinical").

Instructions/Process:

1. Each individual must fill out the program application and send it to Sarah McKibbin via email or fax. (Smckibbin@info4seniors.org, Fax: 937-341-3005 Attn: Sarah McKibbin)
 - An online application is available on the Area Agency on Aging's website: info4seniors.org (click on the box that says workforce shortage initiative)
 - Please send a copy of your ID with the application.
2. The application will be processed by the Area Agency on Aging, PSA2. If approved, the individual will be sent a commitment form to sign and return.
3. Once the commitment form is received, the training site the individual selected will be notified.
4. The individual will complete the registration process at the training site. **Please be aware there are registration deadlines!**
5. The individual will attend the classroom and clinical training. Individuals who meet passing criteria will receive a Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) certificate. **Each school has minimum passing requirements on classroom (tests/exams) and clinical performance. Class attendance is mandatory. If you miss more than 10% of the class time (7.5 hours) you will fail the course. If you fail the course you will have to pay to retake the course.**
6. Individual/Graduate will pick up their CNA certificate from the training site when available and seeks employment.

- CNA/STNA Training Program will cover body mechanics, nutrition, anatomy and physiology, human disease processes, infection control, communication skills, and resident rights. Students will master various personal care skills such as how to help patients bathe, eat, and groom themselves.
- Clinical experiences allow students to demonstrate personal care skills in care settings under the supervision of faculty nurses (clinical may be scheduled on weekends). Clinical Hours: Included in the STNA training program is a mandatory 2-day (16 hours) clinical at an off-site nursing facility. Clinicals can be days, nights, or weekends
- **Requirements:** Driver's License/ID, Social Security Card, Physical, 2 Step TB, and COVID Card/OMCC Religious Exemption Form Completed & Notarized. White Scrubs and White Shoes.

DAYTIME CLASS: Class 8:00 am - 4:00 pm, Monday - Friday 2 weeks

EVENING CLASS: Class 4:30 pm - 9:00 pm, Monday - Friday 3 weeks – **CLINICALS WILL BE DAYTIME HOURS**

- Under the guidance and supervision of our clinical instructors, trainees are provided with theoretical-based classes where basic to advanced nursing topics will be tackled. We give them opportunities to interact with technology and medical equipment under the supervision of our clinical instructors.
- **Requirements:** Driver's License/ID, Social Security Card, Physical, 2 Step TB, and Background check.
 - Hunter Green scrubs are required for the second week of class.
 - All students must have proof of a negative TB skin test within the last twelve months or chest X-ray results.
 - Students must provide their own shoes, and a wristwatch with a second hand.
- The STNA program consists of classroom-based learning activities and community-based clinical experiences. All classroom activities take place at our offices located in Centerville, Ohio. All clinical experiences take place in long term care facilities in the Centerville/Dayton metropolitan area.

DAYTIME CLASS: Class 9:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday - Friday 2 weeks. Clinical hours are 7am -3:30pm.

EVENING CLASS: Class 5:30 pm - 9:30 pm, Monday - Friday 3 weeks. Clinical hours are 7am -3:30pm.
