## **PURPOSE**

Are you unsure of the resources and processes behind Adult Protective Services? Is there a gap in your knowledge about where to turn when you believe abuse is occurring in a home you have been visiting? Are you unsure of how to make a quality APS report?

This workshop will cover Adult Protective Services specific to Montgomery County and addresses general goals and services that apply to all counties. Topics include an in-depth look at Adult Protective Services, how to write a quality report, detecting signs of abuse, and the organization's goals.

Attendees will gain clarification on common misconceptions about Adult Protective services, and hear case examples as well as success stories. This workshop will provide clarification on the role that Adult Protective Services plays in the community and increase awareness on older adult abuse, neglect, and exploitation.
